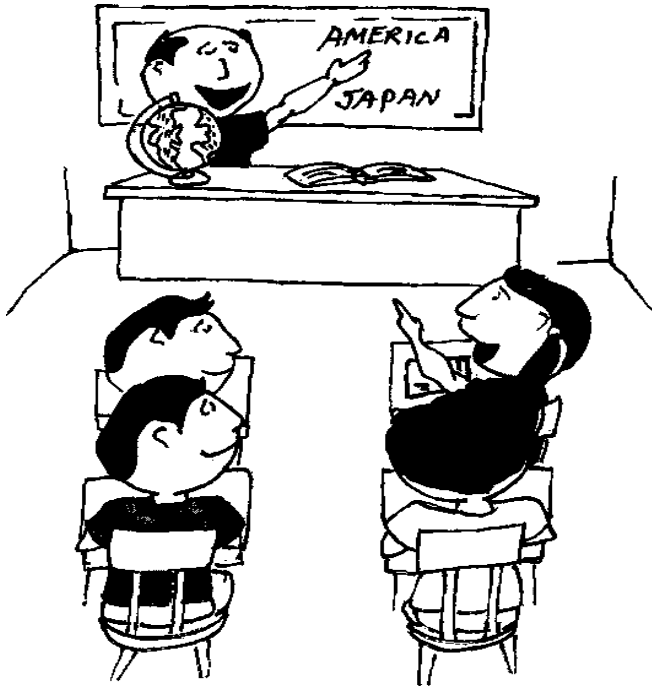
3. The teacher is talking, but has his back is to you. You cannot see the teacher's face. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



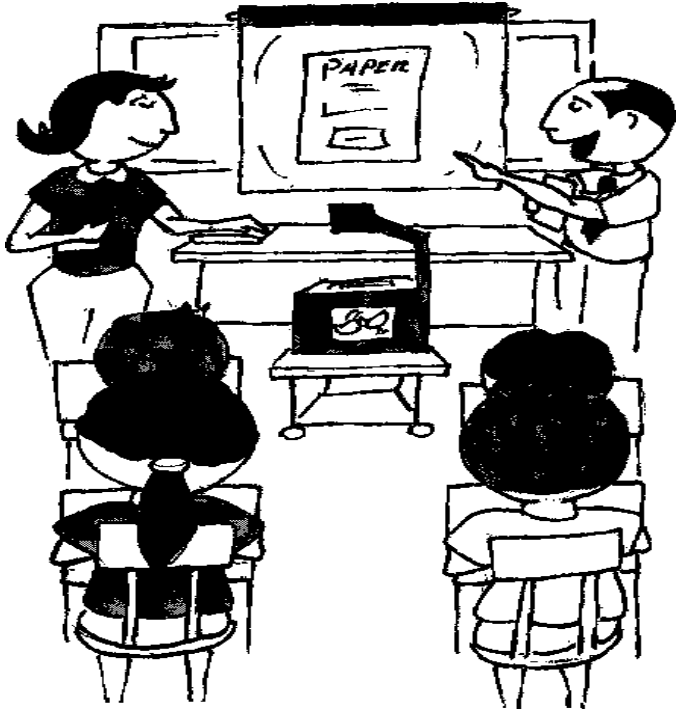
4. The teacher is talking. Other kids are making noise in the hall. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



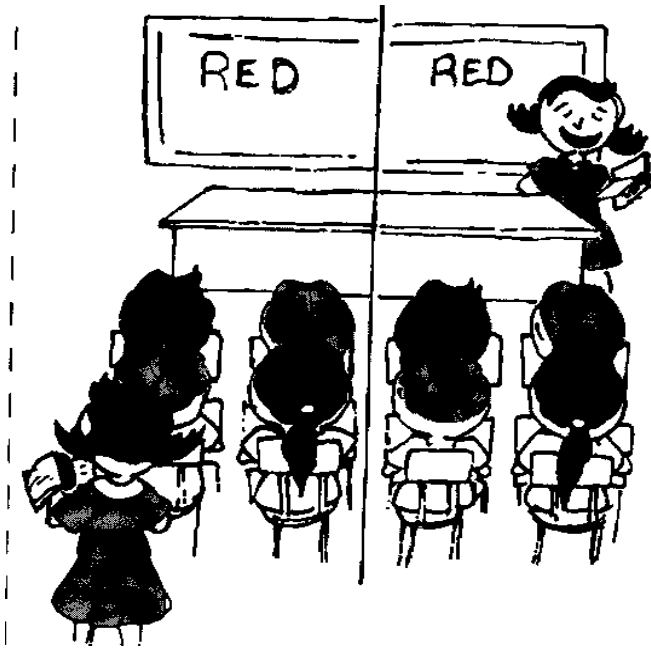

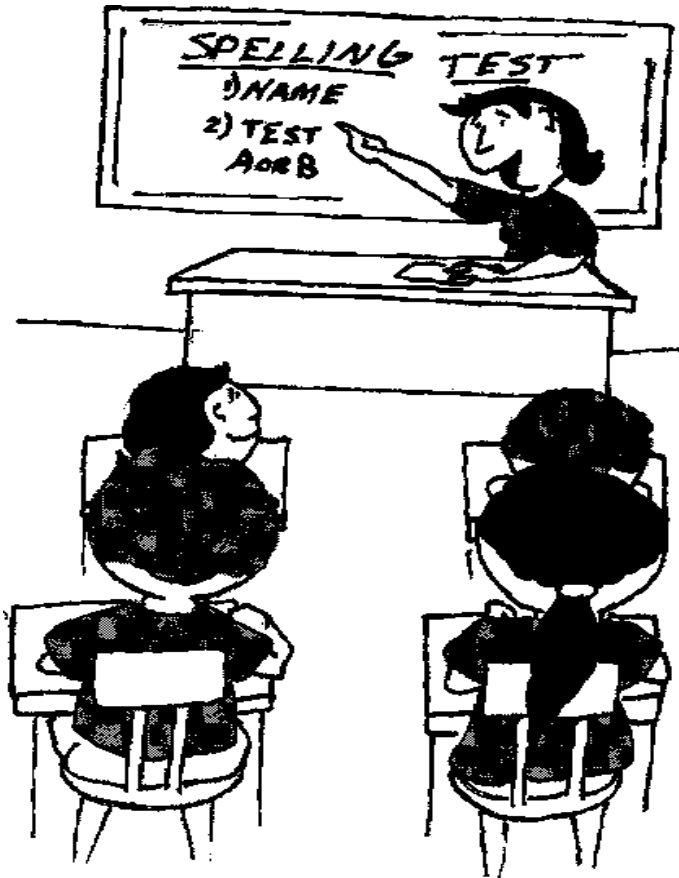

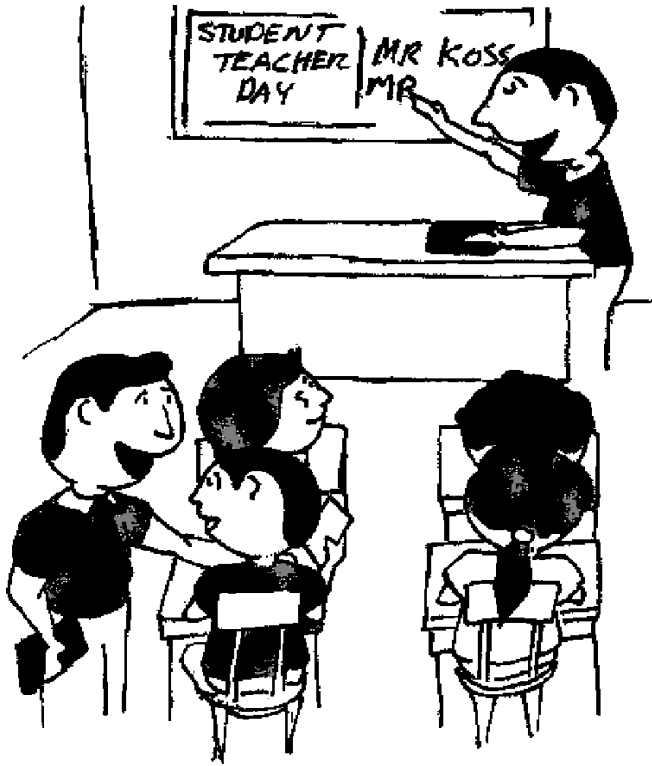
7. The teacher is talking to the class. The teacher is using a projector. The projector is making noise. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



8. The teacher is talking. She is also walking and moving around the room. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



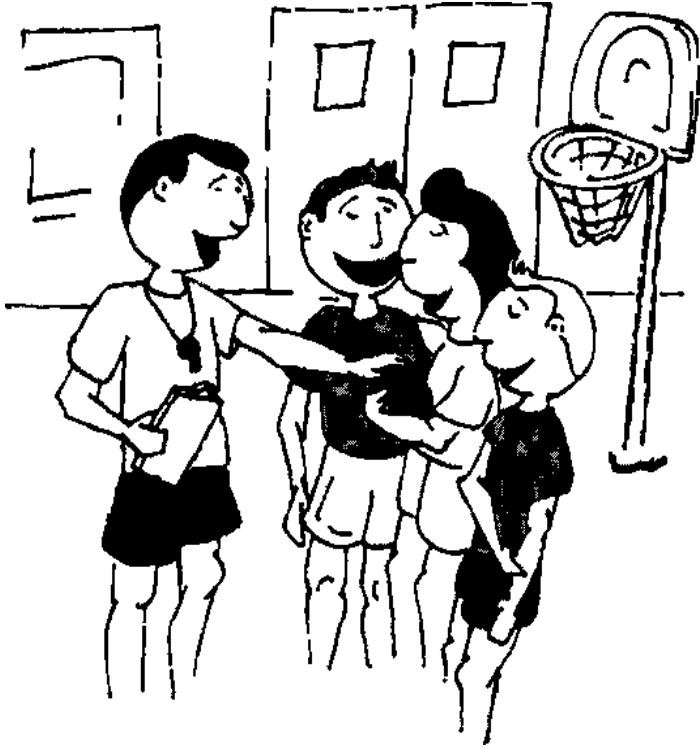
9. The kids are going to take a test. The teacher is giving directions. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



10. One teacher is talking in front of the class. Another teacher is talking to a kid at the same time. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.



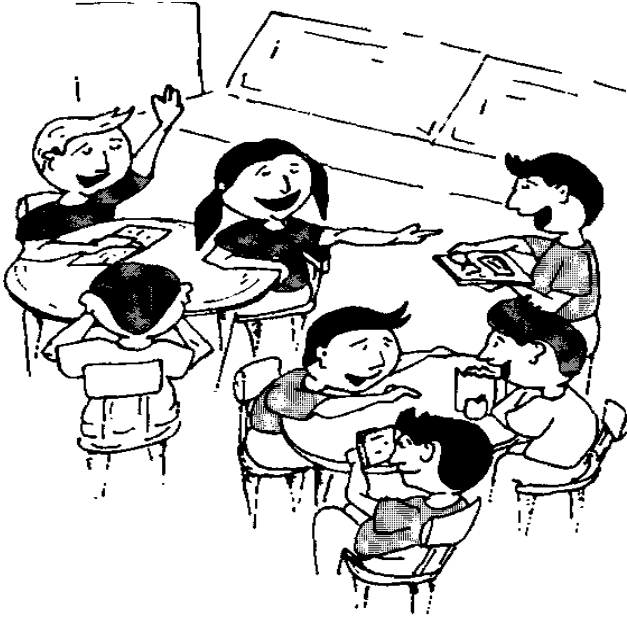
11. The kids are working in small groups. There are other groups working at the same time. The kids are talking and moving papers. Tell me how well you can hear the words the teacher is saying.
