Auditory Skills

- Hear It, Fix IT (HIFI): Auditory memory, auditory comprehension, vocabulary, communication repair
- Rhythm sticks: auditory training, auditory memory
- Mr. Potato Head: prepositions, body parts, auditory memory, communication repair
- HELP books: HELP #s 1-5 = Language Processing, Auditory Processing, Language Flexibility, Social Language Skills, Critical Thinking

- Google docs: forms and doc sharing
- LIFE-R (online, CD or USB drive): Student LIFE = what they currently do, Before LIFE = assesses student's perception of listening difficulty, After LIFE = assesses child's advocacy strategies, Teacher LIFE – rates child's level of advocacy and difficulty/ease of accessing auditory information
