

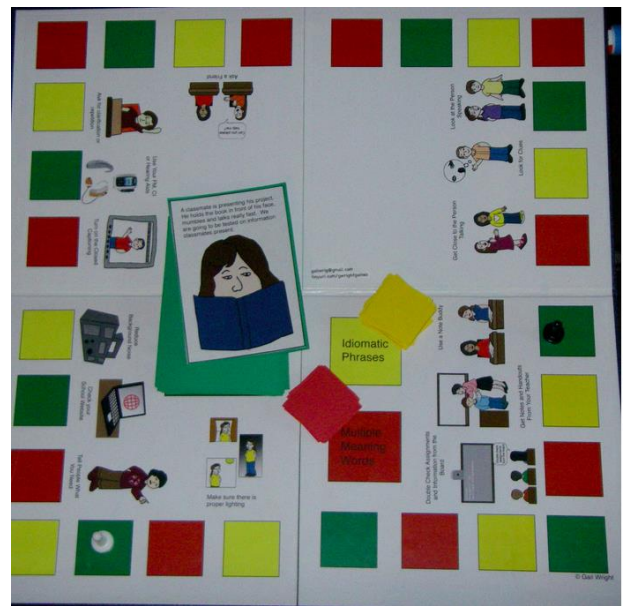
Monkey Talk
