● Never	3



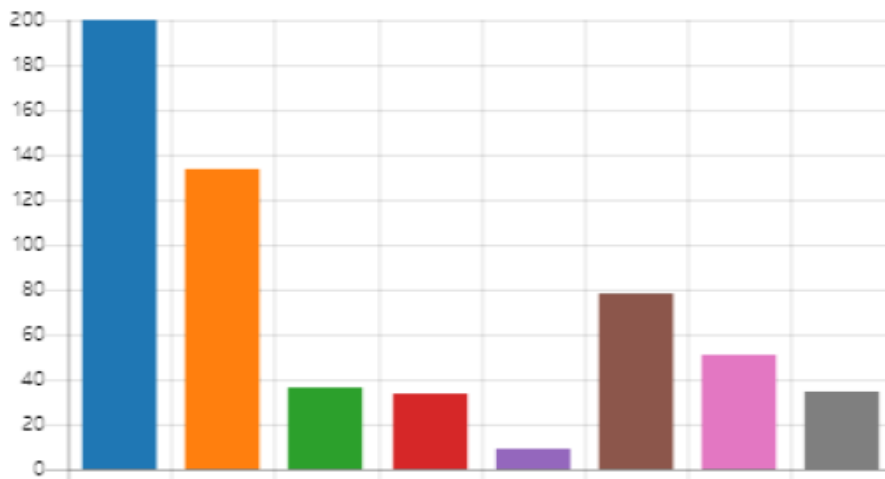
When I think about how hard I have to work to understand what is being said by the teacher and my classmates, in comparison to other students I think I:

● Work less	6



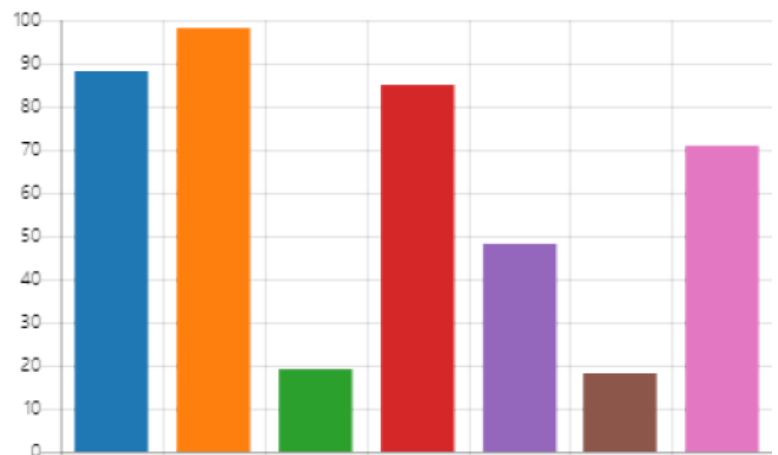
Which of the following is true about your regular class online (click all that are true):
